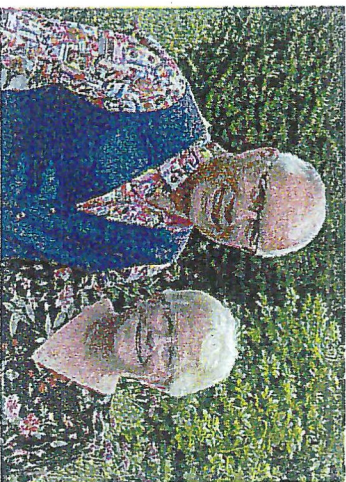


Introducing:

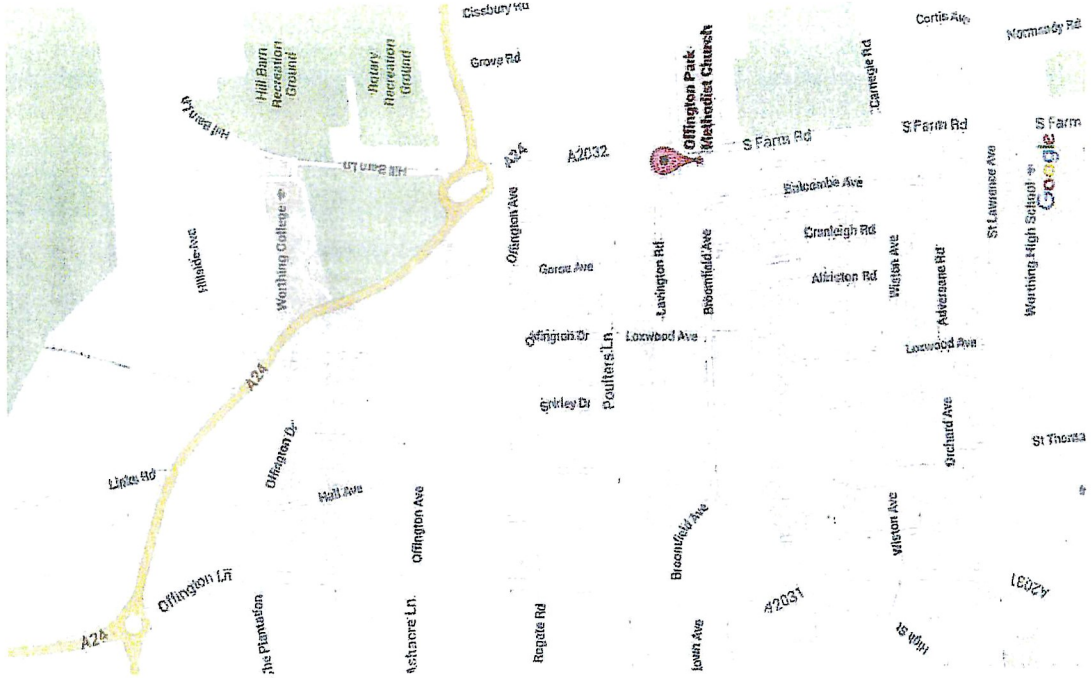
